OTHER

As summers can be quite warm, below are listed some of the favorite local cooling activities.

Lakeview Splash Park - Nampa

This is a smaller city-owned water park. Because it's run by the city of Nampa, entrance fees are minimal. This park is great for families with smaller children - 75% of the park is less than 1.5 feet deep, however, there is a water slide and an area of deeper water for older kids.

HOURS

Afternoon Session: 1:00-4:45 every day

Evening Session: 6:00-8:45 every day

ENTRANCE FEES

\$1.00 to \$1.75 for kids up to age 17

\$2.25 for those 18 and older
